
Purdue Pilots, Inc. Member's Guide

New Members



- 1. Read the constitution on the club's Boilerlink page
- 2. If you have decided to join PPI, please follow "Paying Dues" below
- 3. To get on the scheduler, schedule the plane and schedule an instructor
 - a) Go to <u>http://lai.kal-soft.com/RequestNewLogin.asp</u> and request for an account on Purdue Aviation's scheduler if you don't have one.
 - b) If you are an international student, you MUST inform Purdue Aviation to get TSA authorization PRIOR to commencing any training.
 - c) New pilots can schedule their first flight with a Purdue Aviation certified flight instructor (CFI) via the scheduler. You may ask Purdue Aviation about suggestions on scheduling a specific instructor. In general, we suggest that you avoid switching instructors during your training thus, ensure that your schedule will work with the instructor's. However, keep in mind you can always switch instructors if you are having issues with him/her.
 - d) If you have any problems scheduling an instructor or using the scheduler, please contact Purdue Aviation at (765) 743-9692 or email Rachel Ward at rward@purdueaviationllc.com
- 4. If you are a certificated pilot, you will need a checkout in our aircraft with a Purdue Aviation instructor (can also be done in a non-club Warrior). Schedule a checkout with a Purdue Aviation instructor and let them know you want a check out in the Warrior.

Office Hours

Paying dues

Option 1: Online via COOL

1. Go online to

- 2. Pay dues (note, dues paid online have a 3% surcharge as BOSO charges us this for processing
 - a) Returning members: pay for "Spring 2022 Returning Flying Dues"
- 3. New members: pay for "Spring 2022 New Flying Dues"
 - a) Submit Spring 2022 Membership Information Form (if you have not yet) at https://forms.gle/58pjX1JhjF411uK8A
 - b) Print, complete, and sign waiver at <u>https://engineering.purdue.edu/PPI/forms/PPIreleaseform.pdf</u>
 - c) Get membership card from an officer at office hours or at a business meeting
- 4. Non-flying dues are also available if one would like to still be involved with the club but not fly our aircraft

Option 2: Pay in person with cash or check.

- 1) Go to one of the published office hours or an all-member meeting
 - a. Submit the Membership Information Form (if you have not yet) at https://forms.gle/wwSgx9FmavMiCKzs7
 - b. Print, complete, and sign waiver at <u>https://engineering.purdue.edu/PPI/forms/PPIreleaseform.pdf</u>
 - c. Get membership card from an officer at office hours or at a business meeting
